- SNAC wrist debate – PRC vs 4 corner fusion

- X-ray features of distal radius fractures which need particular attention
- Technical aspects of monoblock VLP placement
- Untreated 6 week old distal radius fracture with displacement and angulation
- The “jumped” lunate facet after VLP
- Prominent volar plate with FPL rupture
- Ulnar sided wrist pain- fate of the ulnar styloid

- Technical aspects of metacarpal plating and intramedullary screw fixation
- The missed dislocation of the MP joint and the CMC
- Non operative treatment of metacarpal fractures with malrotation
